

PRAYER IDEAS FOR THE HOME

1 PSALMS JAR

WRITE DOWN SOME OF YOUR FAVOURITE VERSES FROM THE PSALMS ON SLIPS OF PAPER. PUT THOSE SLIPS OF PAPER IN A JAR. BEFORE A MEAL GET ONE OF THE CHILDREN TO TAKE A SLIP OF PAPER OUT AND READ IT WITH THEM AS A PRAYER

2 WORLD MAP

FIND A WORLD MAP (PHYSICAL OR DIGITAL) AND PUT IT ON A TABLE. ASK THE CHILD WHERE THEY WOULD LIKE TO PRAY FOR. PUT SOMETHING ON THE MAP (LEGO FIGURE/CANDLE/STICKER ETC). PRAY TOGETHER FOR THAT PLACE

3 PAPER AEROPLANE THANKS

MAKE A PAPER AEROPLANE EACH AND THEN THINK OF SOMETHING YOU'RE GRATEFUL FOR. PRAY "THANKYOU GOD FOR _____" AND THROW YOUR PLANE. PICK UP SOMEONE ELSE'S PLANE AND DO THE SAME AGAIN! STOP WHEN YOU'RE ALL THANKED OUT!

4 PLAYDOUGH

GIVE EACH PERSON A LUMP OF PLAYDOUGH AND GET THEM TO SHAPE IT INTO SOMETHING OR SOMEONE THEY WANT TO PRAY FOR. ONCE EVERYONE HAS MADE THEIR SHAPE SPEND SOME TIME PRAYING FOR EACH PRAYER REQUEST ONE BY ONE.

5 CHALKPEN ON THE WINDOW

ASK YOUR CHILDREN WHAT THEY THINK GOD MIGHT WANT TO SAY TO PEOPLE TODAY (GOD LOVES YOU, YOU ARE SPECIAL ETC). GET THEM TO WRITE WHAT THEY THINK WITH CHALK PEN OR WHITEBOARD MARKER ON THE WINDOW (BACKWARDS!)
